Laboratory (Lab) Course Delivery

An organized activity where theories, techniques, or methods are tested, analyzed or demonstrated. Labs are scheduled at separate times from the instruction time and generally focus on students getting hands-on experience of the subject matter, often in a specialized learning space. A course laboratory section is co-requisite to the instruction section at time of registration. Sections would be coded L01, L02, etc.

Major

The primary area of specialization in certain credit programs.

Mandatory Non-Instructional Fees

Fees assessed for supplies, equipment, materials, or services which are not directly related to the delivery of instruction in a course or program.

Non-Academic Admission Requirements

Any admission requirement that is not academic in nature.

Non-Credit

Courses which do not carry a credit value and are not calculated into a registrant's Grade Point Average (GPA).

Not Qualified

The status of an individual who does not satisfy admission requirements.
