

# CRIMINAL JUSTICE - BACHELOR OF

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## BCJ

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The Bachelor of Criminal Justice prepares students for a career in the diverse field of public safety as well as for continuing their education at the graduate level. The curriculum has been shaped through collaboration with industry and focuses on developing skills for success: critical thinking; collaboration; conflict resolution; ethical decision-making; global awareness; inclusivity; communication; leadership; and research. Students will benefit from work-integrated learning and applied research opportunities with industry partners. The program has flexible delivery to accommodate those already working in the field.

### Work Integrated Learning

The college dictates the legal terms and conditions governing the directive field study placement.

Applicants are advised they will be required to undergo a Criminal Record Check prior to enrolling in the placement. The existence of a criminal record may affect placement and future employment prospects. The agencies reserve the right to determine who is considered a suitable candidate.
