

# NURSING AFTER DEGREE - BACHELOR OF

## ADMISSIONS

All applicants applying to the Bachelor of Nursing – After Degree program must apply directly to the University of Lethbridge. Please refer to the U of L admissions information.

Applicants to the BN After Degree must present the following:

- An approved undergraduate degree (a minimum of 30 or more courses (90.0 credit hours) from a recognized degree-granting institution)
- Human Anatomy and Physiology, 6.0 credit hours (two term courses)
- Statistics, 3.0 credit hours (one term course)
- Fine Arts or Humanities courses, 3.0 credit hours (one term course)
- Social science courses, 6.0 credit hours (two term courses)
- Proof of Spoken English Language Proficiency and English Language Proficiency
- Completion and submission of valid CASPer test results

Keep in mind that Human Anatomy and Physiology and Statistics must be completed with 10 years preceding the term of admission. *(Waivers will not be permitted if the ten year limit has passed or if courses taken are less than the required credit weight; these courses will need to be retaken.)*

Admission to this program is competitive.

**Note:** Mid-point grades must be submitted for courses currently in progress.
