The Pre-Pipe Trades certificate program is designed to provide introductory training to students with an interest, but a lack of experience, in plumbing and gas-fitting trades. The program provides technical training in first-period subject matter to develop entry-level skills and safety awareness. Graduates will be eligible to write the Prior Learning Assessment, successful completion will provide credit for first-period technical training.

 Successful completion of English 20-2, Math 20-3 and Science 10, pass Apprenticeship Entrance Exam, or pass mark in all five Canadian General Education Development (GED) tests.

- · Good physical coordination and manual dexterity
- · Mechanical ability
- · Good hearing and colour vision
- The ability to work as a member of a team and adapt to changing tasks and locations
- · Responsibility to do all work tasks expected of a journeyperson
